ORDINANCE NO. 8-13

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REVISING ORD. 24-10 OF THE CITY OF JACKSON SO AS TO ESTABLISH MANAGEMENT AND LIFEGUARD POSITIONS AND WAGES AT THE JACKSON CITY POOL.**

WHEREAS, the wages established by this legislative authority for the seasonal employees of the Jackson City Pools must be increased due to the mandatory increase of minimum wage; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has also found it necessary to abolish the positions of co-managers and to replace those with one manager and with two assistant managers and to establish these positions and wages for the seasonal employees of the Jackson City Pool.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT THE FOLLOWING POSITIONS AND WAGES FOR SEASONAL EMPLOYMENT AT THE JACKSON CITY POOL BE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

Pool Manager / Lifeguard	\$9.85 / hour
Assistant Managers / Lifeguard	\$8.85 / hour
Lifeguards	\$7.85 / hour

Section 2:

Each of these positions shall be seasonal positions. Each position shall be appointed by the Mayor, shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and shall report to the Mayor or his designate. Hourly wages for each position shall be as set forth above but each position shall be subject to an increase equal to periodic increases in minimum wage so that each position remains separated by \$1.00 per hour upon an increase of the Lifeguards' wages. The seasonal employees of the City Pool shall not be entitled to receive health insurance or any other benefits other than those required by Ohio or Federal law.

Section 3:

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
