ORDINANCE NO. 28-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF R & R CONSTRUCTION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$69,121.00 FOR THE MANPOWER BRIDGE PROJECT AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for the Manpower Bridge project which includes completion of a steel beam bridge with spread footing, concrete abutments and steel bar grating deck, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from R & R Construction, for a cost not to exceed \$69,121 and to be paid from line item number 761-7320-54003; and

WHEREAS, the immediate passage of this ordinance constitutes an emergency as delay may cause an increase in price or difficulty in construction and for the further reason that the immediate construction of the bridge will be beneficial to the City and is necessary for the preservation of the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the bid submitted by R & R Construction for a maximum cost of \$69,121.00.

**Section 2.** This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio.

**Section 3.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
