ORDINANCE NO. 25-14

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING PAYMENT TO NEW RIVER ELECTRICAL CORPORATION FOR SERVICES IN FURTHERANCE OF THE 13.2 KV CIRCUIT #1 CONVERSION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this legislative authority has appropriated funds for the 13.2 KV Circuit #1 Conversion Project; and

WHEREAS, New River Electrical Corporation has completed work pursuant to contract, including change orders, and has submitted an invoice for services and materials in the amount of \$89,592.96; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the City that the invoice be paid timely pursuant of the terms of the agreement between New River Electrical Corp. and the City;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THIS LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: Payment in the amount of \$89,592.96 be made to New River Electrical Corporation as follows: \$28,940.99 from 732-7560-54005; and \$60,651.97 from 731-7555-53008.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
