**ORDINANCE NO. 32-14**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION FUND AND ESTABLISHING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SAID FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section 1:** The fund set forth below is hereby created and the appropriation is hereby established for the receipt of project funds as follows:

Fund #298: FEMA Hazard Mitigation Fund



**Section 2.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio so that the revenue to be received by the City can be posted to the proper fund and account and so that this revenue can be appropriated for expenditure. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section 3.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
