ORDINANCE NO. 36-14

AN ORDINANCE RE-NAMING AND RE-DEDICATING MANPOWER PARK AS "MANPOWER PARK, DEDICATED IN HONOR OF ADMIRAL STANLEY R. ARTHUR."

WHEREAS, Admiral Stanley R. Arthur, a graduate of Jackson High School, has had a distinguished career in the U.S. Navy having flown more than 500 combat missions and received 11 awards including the Distinguished Flying Cross and having risen to the Navy's highest ranks commanding the United States Seventh Fleet and serving as Vice Chief of Naval Operations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson is proud of Admiral Stanley Arthur's accomplishments and achievements and positive attention he has brought upon this City; and

WHEREAS, Admiral Stanley Arthur is a positive role model for the people of Jackson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this legislative authority desires recognize Admiral Arthur's achievements and to bestow an honor upon him.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON HEREBY RE-NAMES AND RE-DEDICATES MANPOWER PARK TO NOW BE KNOWN AS "MANPOWER PARK, DEDICATED IN HONOR OF ADMIRAL STANLEY R. ARTHUR".
