ORDINANCE NO. 44-14

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND: ADVANCE OUT TO THE FEMA FLOOD MITIGATION FUND: ADVANCE IN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby makes the following transfers of its appropriations in the following funds as follows:

TRANSFER FROM

110-7750-56010 General Fund: Advance Out

TRANSFER TO

298-0900-40915 FEMA Flood M

FEMA Flood Mitigation Fund: Advance In

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in that it is necessary cover expenses required to be paid in advance and which will be repaid to the general fund once grant funds are received. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section 3.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
