ORDINANCE NO. 73-14

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE ELECTRIC FUND: RIGHT OF WAY REIMBURSEMENT; SEWER FUND: RIGHT OF WAY REIMBURSEMENT; AND WATER FUND: RIGHT OF WAY REIMBURSEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the fund set forth below is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional money as follows:



701-7510-56003	Water Fund: Right of Way Reimbursement	\$119,962.49
711-7525-56003	Sewer Fund: Right of Way Reimbursement	\$170,891.46
731-7555-56003	Electric Fund: Right of Way Reimbursement	\$94,282.17

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare so that these funds may be available to reimburse the General Fund for right of way reimbursements per City policy set forth in Ordinance # 67-09 dated 8/10/09. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
