ORDINANCE NO. 67-15

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE MICRO-MONITORING EFFICIENCY STUDY FUND: ADVANCE OUT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the fund set forth below is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional money, as follows:

<u>FUND</u> <u>AMOUNT</u>

297-7525-56010 Advance Out \$100,000.00

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance is to appropriate funds additional funds so as to repay an advance made from the general fund to the Micro-Monitoring Efficiency Study Fund and is an emergency measure in order that appropriations will be in place to repay the 2014 advance and the repayment is necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the City.

Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
