## ORDINANCE NO. 19-15

### AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE UTILITY DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section 1:** The prior appropriations regarding the fund set forth below is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional money as follows:



**Section 2.** The purchase order created in 2014 was closed in error causing the funds to return to fund #702 and were not available as needed for upcoming projects. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare so the replacement order can be re-established and the projects can proceed and be timely paid. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section 3.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
