## ORDINANCE NO. 56-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO PURCHASE A S-1 CUSTOM PUMPER FIRETRUCK FROM SUTPHEN CORPORATION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$376,371.04 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson Fire Department is in need of a new pumper truck; and

WHEREAS, the City has located a suitable fire truck for sale by Sutphen Corporation, 6450 Eiterman Road, Dublin, Ohio for the price of \$376,371.04; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price for the truck is subject to future price increase and the ability to purchase the truck at the quoted price and at the earliest possible date constitutes a real and present emergency and obtaining such a vehicle is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its residents; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of R.C. 735.05 and by the City's participation in the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program, the conditions obviate requirements of formal bidding, and for the further reason that this matter constitutes an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


**Section 1.** The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to enter an agreement for the purchase of the S-1 Pumper truck from Sutphen Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$376,371.04 upon obtaining suitable financing.

**Section 2.** This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
