ORDINANCE NO. 78 -15

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING APPROPRIATIONS FOR JANUARY 1, 2016, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2016, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: City funds are hereby appropriated for the period of January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, as set forth in "Budget by Object", Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio and for the further reason that it is necessary to adopt a permanent appropriation ordinance for the year 2016 to permit the ordinary business of the City to continue after the expiration of the current budget on December 31, 2015. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
