ORDINANCE NO. ⁸⁰⁻¹⁵~~72~~-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE TO THE MICHIGAN CONFERENCE OF TEAMSTERS WELFARE FUND, 2700 TRUMBULL AVENUE, DETROIT, MI 48216 AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio hereby finds that the Michigan Conference of Teamsters Welfare Fund, submitted the lowest responsible and responsive proposal for the contract for health insurance coverage for City employees as follows:


Section Two. The Mayor and/or Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract for insurance according to the terms of the accepted proposal.

Section Three. This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in order to maintain continuous insurance coverage as required by contract with the bargaining agreements and contracts with the City employees.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to received the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


