ORDINANCE NO. 83-15

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REVISING ORD. 102-08, ORD 75-09 AND ORD 15-10 AND SECTION 929.07 OF THE CITY OF JACKSON CODE OF ORDINANCES SO AS TO INCREASE THE WATER RATES FOR CUSTOMERS OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 929.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Jackson presently sets the rates for water use; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has found it necessary to increase those rates to the amounts set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto, effective immediately and by 3% for each year hereafter beginning on January 1, 2017 in order to continue the operation of the water treatment plant and that the increase is necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT THE FOLLOWING BE AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING WATER RATES AND THAT IT BE NUMBERED AS SECTION 929.07 AND REPLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE, AS CONTAINED IN EXHIBIT "A", ATTACHED HERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary so as to increase those rates in order to continue the operation of the water treatment plant and that the increase is necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
