**ORDINANCE NO. 36-16
(AMENDED)**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN INCOME TAX AT THE RATE OF 1% FOR THE PURPOSES OF MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY'S STREETS, ALLEYS, BRIDGES AND SIDEWALKS, DEMOLITION OF CONDEMNED STRUCTURES, CREEK CLEANING, CONSTRUCTION OF THE FIRE HOUSE ADDITION AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE, RENOVATION AND REPAIR OF CITY BUILDINGS USED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson, without funds generated by a 1% City Income tax, has insufficient funds to maintain the City's streets, alleys, bridges and sidewalks, to demolish condemned structures, for creek cleaning, for construction of the fire house addition, or to maintain, renovate or repair City buildings used for municipal purposes;

WHEREAS, the specifics regarding the income tax are set forth in the attached Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT:

Section One: The provisions of the attached Exhibit "A" levying an income tax on the salaries, wages, commissions, and other compensation and on net profits is hereby approved.

Section Two: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
