

*Tabbed*SPONSOR *Elliott / Hensler***ORDINANCE NO. 67-16****AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL USES OF THE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE RECREATION RESERVE FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section 1:** The legislative authority of the City of Jackson had appropriated the sum of \$120,000 to fund no. 761-7320-54003 pursuant to ORD. No. 49-16 to be used for the replacement of the City pool liner.

**Section 2:** The pool liner replacement project has a cost less than expected and leaves some of the additional appropriated funds available for other needed projects including roof and foundation repairs to the City pool buildings.

**Section 3:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare as the buildings at the City pool are in need of immediate repairs to the foundation and roof and so that the unused funds previously appropriated for the pool liner replacement shall be available for the foundation and roof repairs. This matter constitutes an emergency so that the repairs can be made at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section 4:** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
