ORDINANCE NO. 11-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER A CONTRACT WITH CT CONSULTANTS AND DIRECTING PAYMENT TO CT CONSULTANTS FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES IN FURTHERANCE OF THE MAIN STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

WHEREAS, this legislative authority has appropriated funds for the Main Street reconstruction project; and

WHEREAS, CT Consultants offers a service of a specialized nature that is required by the City for the project; and

WHEREAS, the engineering services must be completed at the earliest possible date so as to allow the City to meet deadlines associated with the project;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THIS LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Payment in the total amount of \$82,700.00 to CT Consultants from the funds and in the amounts set forth as follows:

224-7620-54004 -- \$40,000.00

228-7625-54004 -- \$42,700.00

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
