ORDINANCE NO. 41-16

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE McCARTY LANE RE-BUILD FUND AND ESTABLISHING APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: It is necessary to establish the following fund for McCarty Lane Re-Build with the total appropriations based upon an estimate of total final costs, including grant, loans and City matches, as follows:

448-7525-53064	Project Expense	\$900,000.00

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in that it is necessary to create the fund to post the revenue and expenses and to complete the project at the earliest possible time. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
