## ORDINANCE NO. 70-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL OF CT CONSULTANTS TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE MCCARTY LANE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for proposals for engineering services for the City of Jackson for the McCarty Lane Reconstruction Project, a proposal has been reviewed and a determination has been made to accept the proposal of CT Consultants; and

WHEREAS, CT Consultants is uniquely qualified to complete this project and will do so for an amount not to exceed \$151,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the McCarty Lane Reconstruction Project must be commenced as soon as possible in order to establish a schedule of work on the project that will coincide with receipt of funds from the funding sources and this matter constitutes an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the proposal for engineering services of CT Consultants in an amount not to exceed \$151,000.00 to be paid from the City budget line item 228-7625-54004.

**Section 2.** This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in order to maintain the safety of the City and its residents.

**Section 3.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
