ORDINANCE NO. 13-17

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS SERVICE AND SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR SALE THE STREET PAVING BRICKS TO BE REMOVED AS PART OF THE MAIN STREET PAVING PROJECT THAT ARE NOW OWNED BY THE CITY BUT WILL NO LONGER NEEDED FOR A MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, TO BE SOLD TO THE BEST BIDDER PURSUANT TO R.C. SECTION 721.15.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson is the owner of a large quantity of paving bricks that are to be removed from Main Street as part of a paving project, hereinafter referred to as the "property".

WHEREAS, the City finds that the property, with the exception of a small quantity to be retained for future use, is not needed for a municipal purpose by the City of Jackson, Ohio and that it is in the best interest of the City that it be sold in accordance with R.C. 721.15.

WHEREAS, the City finds that any delay in sale of the property will cause expense and additional labor by having to store the property so that this matter constitutes an emergency to protect the safety, health and welfare of the City.

WHEREAS, the Legislative Authority finds that the City would be better served to sell the property so as to obtain the greatest price from the highest bidder by sealed bid after being advertised for not less than two consecutive weeks nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Jackson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, THAT THE REMOVED PAVING BRICKS BE ADVERTISED FOR SALE FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE WEEKS NOR MORE THAN FOUR WEEKS, IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE CITY OF JACKSON AND THAT THE PROPERTY BE SOLD TO THE HIGHEST BIDDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

OPEN MEETING. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and that these deliberations of this council and its committees resulted in such formal action, or in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


