ORDINANCE NO. 69-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO REQUIRE AUTHORIZATION OF THIS BODY FOR EXPENDITURES BY THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR FOR PURCHASE OR LEASE OF AUTOMOBILES, TRUCKS, TRACTORS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT NOT USED TO MAINTAIN WATER PRODUCTION, SEWER PROCESSING OR REPAIR OF ELECTRIC SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, in order to best appropriate the funds of the City, the legislative authority for the City of Jackson has determined that it is necessary to require approval for expenditures by the Service-Safety Director of the City for the purchase or lease of automobiles, trucks, tractors and other equipment not used to maintain water production, sewer processing or repair of electric system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR SHALL NOT AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURES FOR THE PURCHASE OR LEASE OF AUTOMOBILES, TRUCKS, TRACTORS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT NOT USED TO MAINTAIN WATER PRODUCTION, SEWER PROCESSING OR REPAIR OF ELECTRIC SYSTEM UNLESS FIRST AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED BY ORDINANCE.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
