ORDINANCE NO. 67-18

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN INCOME TAX AT THE ANNUAL RATE OF 1% FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson, without funds generated by a 1% City Income tax, does not have sufficient funds to operate the City of Jackson Police Department; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as a sufficiently funded police department is essential to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the specifics regarding the income tax are set forth in the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by reference.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section One</u>: The provisions of the attached Exhibit "A", incorporated herein, levying an income tax on the salaries, wages, commissions, and other compensation and on net profits is hereby approved as in accordance with ORC section 718.04, with said section incorporated herein, and is an annual tax levied on the income of every person residing in or earning or receiving income in the municipality of Jackson, Ohio and the tax shall be measured by municipal taxable income and shall be effective as of January 1, 2019;

<u>Section Two</u>: the tax rate shall be 1% annually on the municipal taxable income and shall be subject to those credits set forth in Exhibit "A" attached and incorporated herein;

Section Three: The purposes of the tax shall be for the operation of the City of Jackson Police Department.

Section Four: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance as a sufficiently funded Police Department is necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare of the City and its citizens. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
