ORDINANCE NO. 19-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER, IN AN AMOUNT \$100.00 PLUS THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SWITCHYARD FOR THE PURCHASE OF .913 ACRES LOCATED ON SSR LOT 57 AS IT WAS THE HIGHEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for purchase of .913 acres located on Scioto Salt Reserve lot 57 from the City of Jackson with the condition of the bid being the construction of a switchyard facility on the real property being conveyed, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the highest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the highest and best responsive bid was from American Electric Power, for \$100.00 plus the construction on the real property a switchyard facility capable of interconnecting with the existing 69KV transmission system to provide up to 37MW of electrical power to the newly constructed sub-station serving the City of Jackson, Ohio; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a deed and other documents of conveyance as required accept the bid submitted by American Electric Power.

Section 2. In order that the switchyard project may be completed timely, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
