## **ORDINANCE NO. 22-18**

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE DRUG OFFENSE FUND FOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the fund set forth below is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional money as follows:

<u>FUND</u>	CATEGORY	<u>AMOUNT</u>
275-7110-53004	Communications	\$2,000.00
275-7110-53013	Supplies & Materials	\$5,000.00
275-7110-53064	Canine Expense	\$2,000.00

275-7110-53004 Communications –\$2000 These funds will be used to pay for drug enforcement communications lines and products.

275-7110-53013 Supplies & Materials – \$5000 These funds will be used to purchase any and all drug enforcement related supplies, materials and products.

275-7110-53064 Canine Expenses – \$2000 These funds will be used to pay all the K9's medical and other supplies needed. K9 is used for drug enforcement, drug prevention and drug education.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare as these funds are for additional appropriations necessary pay drug enforcement related expenses as set forth above. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
