## ORDINANCE NO. 82-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF TATMAN ASSOCIATES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$503,000.00 FOR THE JAMESTOWN SUBSTATION STEEL PACKAGE PROJECT AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for the Jamestown Substation Steel Package project, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from TATMAN ASSOCIATES, for a cost not to exceed \$503,000.00, and to be paid from line item number 405-7555-54005; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the bid submitted by TATMAN ASSOCIATES for an amount not to exceed \$503,000.00 and to execute those documents necessary for the completion of the project with this bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> In order that the project may be completed timely and for the bid price, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section 3.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
