## ORDINANCE NO. 18-19

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REVISING ORDINANCE 18-17 SO AS TO MODIFY THE RATE OF PAY TO \$25.00 PER GAME FOR ALL PERSONS SERVING AS BASEBALL OR SOFTBALL UMPIRES FOR THE JACKSON RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this legislative authority finds it beneficial to the City to repeal and amend Ord. 18-17 so as change the rate of pay for persons serving the City Recreation Department as umpires for baseball or softball to \$25.00 per game commencing, retroactively, as doing so will not impose any additional burdens or affect substantial rights of persons, at the start of the 2019 baseball/softball season; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency and its passage is necessary to preserve the public health, safety and welfare in order that the City Recreation Department can hire a sufficient number of qualified umpires for the baseball and softball seasons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT THIS MATTER CONSTITUTES AN EMERGENCY AND THAT ORDINANCE 18-17 IS HEREBY REPEALED AND AMENDED AND THE COMPENSATION PAID TO UMPIRES BEGINNING WITH THE 2019 SEASON OF THE JACKSON RECREATION DEPARTMENT BASEBALL OR SOFTBALL PROGRAMS SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

## UMPIRES (Baseball/Softball)

Certified Umpires, including current and former high school varsity (grades 9-12) baseball or softball coaches	\$30.00\$25.00/game
Umpires with Training Session	\$20.00\$25.00/game
All other umpires	\$15.00\$25.00/game

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance and its passage is necessary to preserve the public health, safety and welfare for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in

a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
