ORDINANCE NO. 51-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RENAMING FUND No. 256, FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: There is presently a fund created in 1994 for use for federal law enforcement funds and that fund is now unused and that there is now a need for this fund to be used for forfeiture money received pursuant to RC section 2981.13, so that that the name of the fund should be changed as follows:

FROM:

Fund #256: Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund

TO:

Fund #256: Law Enforcement Trust Fund

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare as this fund should be renamed and repurposed at the earliest possible date to be used for forfeiture money received in accordance with State law. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


