ORDINANCE NO. 08-21

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING ORD. 92-99 REGARDING POLICE PERSONNEL AS SET FORTH IN THE CITY OF JACKSON CODIFIED ORDINANCES AS SECTION 131.01.

WHEREAS, ORD 92-99, as contained in Section 131.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Jackson, established the personnel for the Jackson Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has determined it necessary to revise the section 131.01 of the City of Jackson Codified Ordinances as set forth below; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT ORD 92-99 BE AMENDED AND REPEALED AND SECTION 131.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON BE AMENDED, AS SET FORTH BELOW WITH THOSE STRUCK THROUGH PORTIONS BEING REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH THE UNDERLINED LANGUAGE SHOWING THE AMENDMENTS TO THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE AND THAT IT BE REPLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE, IN REGULAR TEXT.

131.01 PERSONNEL.

The Police Department shall be composed of the following officers and other members:


- (a) One Chief.
- ~~(b) One Assistant Chief.~~
- ~~(c)~~ (b) Not to exceed ~~five~~ four Sergeants.
- ~~(d)~~ (c) Not to exceed ~~fifteen~~ seven Police Officers, or, if there are less than four Sergeants, the number of Police Officers may be increased but the combined number of Police Officers and Sergeants shall not exceed eleven.
- ~~(e)~~ (d) Not to exceed ~~two Secretaries~~ one Secretary/Dispatcher.
- ~~(f)~~ (e) Not to exceed ~~six Radiomen~~ five Dispatchers.
- ~~(g)~~ (f) Temporary Police as required.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
