## ORDINANCE NO. 27-21

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 521.11 TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON REQUIRING PLACEMENT OF STREET NUMBERS ON BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF JACKSON, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby determines it necessary to require owners, agents, lessees, occupants or other persons having control of buildings within the City of Jackson to maintain legible street numbers on buildings so that the buildings may be located by emergency personal and others as may be required; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT THE FOLLOWING BE ADDED AND MADE PART OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AND THAT IT BE PLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE AT ITS NEXT PUBLICATION AS SECTION 521.11, AS FOLLOWS:

## **521.11. HOUSE NUMBERING**

- (A) The owner, agent, lessee, occupant, or other person having control of any building in the City upon a street to which street numbers of buildings have been assigned shall cause the proper arabic numbers to be placed on and continuously maintained on the fanlight, transom, door, entrance, steps or gate, or other conspicuous place on the building facing the street, or if not visible on the building, then near the walk or driveway to the building, in such a manner that the number may at all times be legible and visible from the street pavement. If sides of a building front multiple streets, the number shall be placed on a side of the building fronting the street for which the number has been assigned.
- (B) Violation of this section shall constitute an unclassified misdemeanor and subject to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Any such violation or failure to comply shall constitute a separate offense on each successive day continued.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
