ORDINANCE NO. 30- 21

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING THE CITY OF JACKSON'S CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 1327.02 GOVERNING SWIMMING POOL ENCLOSURES.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has published certain general and permanent ordinances in a volume of Codified Ordinances including section 1327.02 governing swimming pool enclosures; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has determined it necessary to revise section 1327.02 regarding swimming pool enclosures and above ground pools with vertical sides of four feet or greater; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT SECTION 1327.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON BE REPEALED AND AMENDED REGARDING SWIMMING POOL ENCLOSURES FOR CERTAIN ABOVE GROUND POOLS, AS SET FORTH BELOW WITH THOSE STRUCK THROUGH PORTIONS BEING REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH THE UNDERLINED LANGUAGE SHOWING THE AMENDMENTS TO THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE AND THAT IT BE REPLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE, IN REGULAR TEXT.

1327.02 ENCLOSURE REGULATIONS.

(a) No person shall locate, construct, install, make, change or use a private swimming pool, club swimming pool, public swimming pool or commercial swimming pool unless such pool or the premises upon which it is located is enclosed by a fence or other boundaries not less than forty-eight inches in height, measured from ground level, so constructed, and of such strength that children under the ages of seven are unable to pass through, and the gates of such fence shall be constructed so they may be locked when the pool is not in use. Gates and entrances shall be locked or latched whenever the pool is not in use. Gates and entrances shall be locked or latched whenever the pool is not supervised by a person at least fourteen years of age. Above ground pools will be considered in compliance if all sides are a minimum of four (4) feet in height, measured from the ground and the ladder or other access points are raised or locked when not in use.

~~—(b)— No person shall locate, construct, install, make change or use a swimming pool either permanent or portable and constructed aboveground, unless such pool has perpendicular sides of not less than three feet.~~


