ORDINANCE NO. 36-21

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING THE CITY OF JACKSONS CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 945.19 ON COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF BRUSH.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has published certain general and permanent ordinances in a volume of Codified Ordinances including section 945.19 for the collection and disposal of brush and tree limbs; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has determined it necessary to revise section 945.19 as to collection and disposal of brush and tree limbs by the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT SECTION 945.19 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON BE REPEALED AND AMENDED AS TO THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF BRUSH, AS SET FORTH BELOW WITH THOSE STRUCK THROUGH PORTIONS BEING REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH THE UNDERLINED LANGUAGE SHOWING THE AMENDMENTS TO THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE AND THAT IT BE REPLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE, IN REGULAR TEXT.

945.19 COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF BRUSH.

~~If any resident hires or employs any person, whether an individual or a business entity, to cut and remove brush from the resident's premises, then the resident shall be solely responsible for the collection, removal and proper disposal of the brush from the resident's premises.~~

~~If any resident cuts and removes brush from the resident's premises, and the resident has not hired or employed any person, whether an individual or business entity, to perform the cutting and removal of the brush, then the City will collect, remove and dispose of the brush if the brush has been properly placed in an appropriate pick-up location.~~

If any resident cuts brush or tree limbs from the resident's premises, and the resident has not hired or employed any person, whether an individual or business entity to perform the removal, then the resident may contact the City Utility Office to request the City collect, remove and dispose of the brush. Brush and limbs must be properly placed at the street, an improved alley capable of handling the required equipment or in a otherwise agreed upon pick-up location at a charge.
