ORDINANCE 58-21

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A POSITION WITHIN THE AFSCME UNION AND ESTABLISHING A PAY RATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Jackson, Ohio:

WHEREAS, the City Council is responsible for the creation of new positions within the City and setting the compensation of such positions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended and this legislative authority desires to create the position of Wastewater Treatment Facility Class III Operator to be included within the City bargaining unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO:

Section 1: The position of Wastewater Treatment Facility Class III Operator shall be in the created.

Section 2: The salary shall be as follows:

Entry Level for current City employees, new hires would follow the 80% starting wage.

Class II - \$23.89

Class II — within 12 months' completion of the PRETREATMENT FACILITY INSPECTION training program and the OIT (Operator in Training) program - \$25.89

Class II — within 18 months obtain Class III OEPA License - \$27.80

Class III - \$25.89

Class III - within 12 months' completion of the PRETREATMENT FACILITY INSPECTION training program and the OIT (Operator in Training) program - \$27.80

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure as the position created is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and the safety of the residents of the City of Jackson.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
