ORDINANCE NO. 39-22

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 38-22 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, that ORD. 38-22 (previously presented and misnumbered as ORD 35-22 is hereby **repealed** in its entirety.

Section 2. The repeal of the ordinance is necessary to correct the accounts of the City and to best allow for a proper transfer of funds by future ordinance. This is an emergency necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare so that the City accounts accurately reflect the proper transfer of funds. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
