ORDINANCE NO. 63- 22

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COURT STREET BETWEEN PORTSMOUTH AND BROADWAY STREETS AS A ONE-WAY STREET.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson and its administration, pursuant to R.C. section 4511.07 and City Code 305.01, has the authority to designate and mark certain streets within the City's jurisdiction as one-way streets; and

WHEREAS, it has been requested by the Jackson County Commissioners that the City of Jackson consider making Court Street between Portsmouth and Broadway Streets a one-way street so that the flow of traffic will be from Broadway Street to Portsmouth Street to improve parking around the County court facilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT COURT STREET BETWEEN PORTSMOUTH STREET AND BROADWAY STREET IS A ONE-WAY STREET WITH THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC BEING FROM BROADWAY STREET TO PORTSMOUTH STREET AND THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR SHALL PLACE THE APPROPRIATE TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS AND DEVICES, PAINTED OR OTHERWISE MARKED, FOR THE PROPER CONTROL OF TRAFFIC AND THE PARKING OF VEHICLES.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
