ORDINANCE NO. 70- 22

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING SECTION 945.19 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON GOVERNING COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF BRUSH.**

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby enacts and codifies the laws, rules and regulation governing collection and disposal of brush within the City of Jackson and directs that Section 945.19 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Jackson be amended as follows:

**945.19 COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF BRUSH.**

If any resident cuts brush or tree limbs from the resident's premises, and the resident has not hired or employed any person, whether an individual or business entity to perform the removal, then the resident may contact the City Utility Office to request the City collect, remove and dispose of the brush. Brush and limbs must be properly placed at the street, an improved alley capable of handling the required equipment or in an otherwise agreed upon pick-up location at a charge. In accordance with section 945.01 a resident does not include a property owner that does not reside on the premises and such non-resident property owner may not request collection or removal of brush by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT SECTION 945.19 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, WITH THE LANGUAGE THAT APPEARS IN UNDERLINED PRINT, AS SET FORTH ABOVE, BE ADDED AND MADE PART OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AND THAT IT BE PLACED, IN REGULAR TYPE TEXT, WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE AT ITS NEXT PUBLICATION.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 122.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
