ORDINANCE NO. 71-23

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE HAMMERTOWN LAKE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the fund set forth below is hereby modified to appropriate additional money to the Hammertown Improvements Project Fund as follows:

422-7320-53066	Project Expense - Hammertown	\$25,000.00

Section 2. This matter constitutes an emergency as additional appropriation is needed to cover expenses related to the Hammertown Lake Improvements project in a timely manner. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare so that expenses for the museum can be timely paid. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
