## RESOLUTION NO. 25-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUPPORT TO THE JACKSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT, TO SUPPORT AN APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THE OHIO JOB READY SITES PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Department of Development, provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of filling statewide gaps in Ohio's site offerings market;

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson desires to support Jackson County in their application to receive financial assistance for the development of Salt Creek Industrial Park under the Ohio Job Ready Sites Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson has the primary jurisdiction over the geographical area, Salt Creek Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson has the primary jurisdiction over water, sewer, and electric utilities at the Salt Creek Industrial Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> That Jackson City Council authorizes support to Jackson County in their application to receive financial assistance for the development of Salt Creek Industrial Park under the Ohio Job Ready Sites Grant Program.

<u>Section 2.</u> That Jackson City Council will continue to provide water, sewer, and electric utilities to the Salt Creek Industrial Park.

Section 3. This Resolution is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that it is necessary for the City of Jackson to immediately commence with this action in order to comply with the application processes and timelines. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section 4.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section 5. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
