**RESOLUTION NO. 3-09**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE SOUTHERN OHIO DIVERSIFICATION INITIATIVE (SODI) TO DEVELOP AND REDEVELOP THE URANIUM ENRICHMENT FACILITY LOCATED NEAR PIKETON, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Southern Ohio Diversification Initiative (SODI) is actively involved in efforts to develop and redevelop the Uranium Enrichment Facility located near Piketon, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the development and redevelopment of the Uranium Enrichment Facility would be of great benefit to the citizens of Jackson and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council desires to formally support the efforts of SODI.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Jackson City Council hereby supports fully all efforts of SODI to develop and redevelop the Uranium Enrichment Facility located near Piketon, Ohio.

**Section 2.** This Resolution is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that any development and redevelopment of the Uranium Enrichment Facility will be of great benefit to the citizens of Jackson and the surrounding area. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section 3.** In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**Section 4.** This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
