RESOLUTION NO. 23-09

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE BROADBAND CONCEPT TO COME TO JACKSON COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council believes a countywide broadband concept would be beneficial to the citizens of the City of Jackson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council desires to formally support and endorse the Broadband Concept to come to Jackson County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. The Jackson City Council hereby supports and endorses the Broadband Concept to come to Jackson County, Ohio, and this Council hereby supports and endorses the Jackson County Commissioners in their efforts towards achieving a Broadband Concept for Jackson County, Ohio.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that the Jackson City Council desires to promptly set forth its support for the Broadband Concept to come to Jackson County, Ohio. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
