RESOLUTION NO. 11-10

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND THANKING THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, THOSE CURRENT SERVING, PAST SERVING, AND FALLEN, FOR THEIR BRAVERY, DEDICATION, AND SERVICE TO THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, May 9 through May 15 is National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council desires to formally recognize and thank law enforcement officers of the City of Jackson, Ohio, those currently serving, serving in the past, and those who have fallen, for their dedication, bravery, and service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. In recognition of National Police Week, Jackson City Council hereby recognizes and honors its law enforcement officers, those currently serving, those who have served in the past, and those who have fallen. Council thanks its law enforcement officers for their dedication, bravery, and service, in making the City of Jackson a safer and better place in which to reside.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that Jackson City Council desires to honor its law enforcement officers during National Police Week, which is May 9 through May 15. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
