RESOLUTION NO. 1-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS AND ACTIONS TO ENTER INTO ANY NECESSARY OR REQUIRED AGREEMENTS AND TO COOPERATE WITH THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A PROJECT TO RESURFACE STATE ROUTE 776 FROM THE WEST CORPORATION LIMIT NORTH TO THE INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 139 LYING WITHIN THE CITY OF JACKSON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the following Final Resolution enacted by the City of Jackson, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority/Local Public Agency or "LPA", in the matter of the stated described project; and

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of September, 2009, the LPA enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project:

Resurfacing the pavement on State Route 776 from the west corporation limit north to the intersection of State Route 139, lying with the City of Jackson; and

WHEREAS, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The City agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement, less the amount of Federal-aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation.

Also, the City of Jackson agrees to assume and bear the entire cost and expense of the installation and/or repair of curb ramps which are necessary to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The share of the cost of the LPA is now estimated in the amount of **Forty Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty and - - - 00/100 Dollars, (\$40,830.00)**, but said estimated amount is to be adjusted in order that the LPA's ultimate share of said improvement shall correspond with said percentages of actual costs when said actual costs are determined; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described highway and has transmitted copies of the same to the legislative authority; and

WHEREAS, The LPA desire the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.
