RESOLUTION NO. 08-13

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND DECLARING MARCH, 2013, AS AMERICAN LEGION MONTH TO RECOGNIZE THE CONTRIBUTIONS AND SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE AMERICAN LEGION.

WHEREAS, the American Legion was established by Congress in 1919 following World War I and has since become this Nation's largest veterans service organization with over 14,000 Legion Posts and nearly 3 million members; and

WHEREAS, the American Legion is active in the City of Jackson where it advocates patriotism, honor, promotes a strong national security and provides valuable services and contributions to its members and the citizens of this community; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of Jackson, Ohio desires to recognize the contributions of the American Legion to this community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, THAT THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2013 IS DECLARED AND RECOGNIZED AS AMERICAN LEGION MONTH.
