**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR APPALACHIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE 1 PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio is requiring the City of Jackson to make improvements to their existing wastewater treatment plant , and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson does not have the funds available within its budget to finance the project, it is imperative that the city seek funding from outside programs.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jackson, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application for \$250,000 in Appalachian Regional Commission grant funding necessary to finance a portion of the project, and


Section 2: This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure for the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Jackson; and

Section 3: This resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon final passage.


