RESOLUTION NO. 4-15

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS AND/OR THE CLEAN OHIO TRAILS PROGRAMS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Recreational Trails Program and the Clean Ohio Trails Program;

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson desires financial assistance under the Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Program and that there is a deadline for the application to be made and that the award of the funds are beneficial to and needed to protect the health safety and welfare of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Jackson Council as follows:

- 1 The City of Jackson Council approves filing an application for Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Program financial assistance;
- That Mayor Randy Heath is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for potential funding assistance;
- That the City of Jackson agrees to obligate those funds, up to a maximum amount of \$120,000, needed to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Program.
- 4. That this is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to as there is a deadline by which to apply. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
