RESOLUTION NO. 16-17

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO AN OHIO EPA/OWDA WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSON FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PARKVIEW TO WEST MAIN STREET SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson seeks to complete the construction of the Parkview to West Main Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson intends to apply for an Ohio EPA/OWDA Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) to finance a portion of the construction of the Parkview to West Main Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA/OWDA requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Jackson City Council, Jackson County, Ohio:

SECTION I: That it is necessary to complete the construction of the Parkview to West Main Street Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Jackson.

~~SECTION II: That it is necessary to apply for a loan from the Ohio EPA/OWDA Water Pollution Control Loan Fund.~~

SECTION III: That the Mayor of the City of Jackson be and is hereby authorized to request from the Ohio EPA/OWDA WPCLF Fund the financing required to complete the project.

SECTION IV: That the method of repayment of moneys loaned from the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund shall be wastewater revenues generated from City of Jackson wastewater customers.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
