A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE SERVICE OF ANTHONY COYAN TO THE CITY OF JACKSON, TO THE JAMESTOWN CEMETERY AND TO THE CITIZENS OF JACKSON, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Anthony Coyan, with his special interest in the Revolutionary War veterans of Jackson County and his devotion to the restoration of the Jamestown Cemetery, had devoted many hours to the recovery, cleaning, and erection of fallen headstones in the Jamestown Cemetery; and

~~WHEREAS, Anthony Coyan spent many hours in research of the Revolutionary War veterans from Jackson County and compiled a list of these veterans to be preserved as part of Jackson's history;~~

WHEREAS, Anthony Coyan was a member of the Jackson County Chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society, and as a member, was active in securing a grant for the erection of period style fence for the Jamestown Cemetery and did much of the work himself for the construction of the fence; and

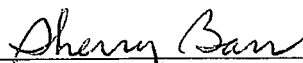

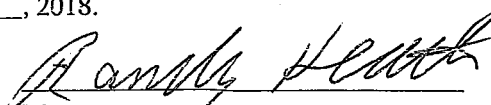
