RESOLUTION NO. 15-18

AN RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE AND SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR SALE THE 2014 MERCURY 25 JET POWER MOTOR THAT IS NOW OWNED BY THE CITY BUT WILL NO LONGER NEEDED FOR A MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, TO BE SOLD TO THE BEST BIDDER PURSUANT TO R.C. SECTION 721.15.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson is the owner of a 2014 Mercury 25 jet power motor, model number 1A36371ER, serial number OR605419, originally to be used by the Jackson Fire Department, hereinafter referred to as the "property".

WHEREAS, the City finds that the property is not needed for a municipal purpose by the City of Jackson, Ohio and that it is in the best interest of the City that it be sold in accordance with R.C. 721.15.

WHEREAS, the Legislative Authority finds that the City would be better served to sell the property so as to obtain the greatest price from the highest bidder after being advertised for not less than two consecutive weeks nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Jackson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, THAT THE 2014 MERCURY 25 JET POWER MOTOR BE ADVERTISED FOR SALE FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE WEEKS NOR MORE THAN FOUR WEEKS, IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE CITY OF JACKSON AND THAT THE PROPERTY BE SOLD TO THE HIGHEST BIDDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

OPEN MEETING. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and that these deliberations of this council and its committees resulted in such formal action, or in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
