RESOLUTION NO. 35-19

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE O.P.W.C. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$347,700.00 TO USE FOR THE HIGH STREET BRIDGE PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City requires assistance to fund the High Street Bridge project and financial assistance may be available in the form of a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission (O.P.W.C.); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is authorized to make application for funds from the O.P.W.C. in an amount not to exceed \$347,000.00 and to execute all documents necessary to obtain the funding from the O.P.W.C.; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as an immediate application will increase the likelihood of the application being granted and the award of the funds shall permit the project to proceed, thereby benefiting the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and, therefore:

Section One. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the O.P.W.C in the amount set forth herein and to execute all documents and agreements as may be required by the O.P.W.C. for the required funding.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reason set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
