## **RESOLUTION NO. 23-19**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SMALL CITIES GRANT PROGRAM TO REPAIR AND RE-PAVE BROADWAY STREET FROM WATER STREET TO ROUTE 35 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation administers financial assistance for public projects through the Small Cities Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City is in need of repairing and re-paving Broadway Street from Water Street to State Route 32; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as an immediate application may increase the opportunity for an award of the funds and an award of funds shall permit the project to proceed, thereby benefiting the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and, therefore:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Jackson council as follows:

- 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson authorizes the filing of an application for financial assistance through the Small Cities Grant Program;
- 2. That Mayor Randy Heath is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Transportation and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for funding assistance;
- 3. That this is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reasons set forth above. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
- 4. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberation of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
