RESOLUTION NO. 36-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ENTER INTO AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT TO FILL THE POSITION OF HEAD DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRIC AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson, Ohio has created the position of Head of Department of Electric; and

WHEREAS, terms of the contract, attached hereto, have been negotiated with the Harley T. Woltz for the position of Head of Department of Electric.

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the City that the contract may be approved so that operations of the department is uninterrupted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON THAT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO ENTER INTO THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT ATTACHED HERETO TO FILL THE POSITION OF HEAD OF DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRIC AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR THE REASONS SET FORTH HEREIN.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
