RESOLUTION NO. 01-20

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RES 44-19 THAT AUTHORIZED PAYMENT OF LEGAL FEES NOT TO EXCEED \$8,208.25 FOR LEGAL SERVICES TO DEFEND THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson adopted RES 44-19 that authorized the payment of legal fees in an amount not to exceed \$8,208.25 that were incurred by then Mayor Randy Heath; and


WHEREAS, this legislative authority now wishes to repeal RES 44-19 and to withdraw the authorization to pay the legal fees as were approved therein; and

WHEREAS, an account has not been identified from which the funds can be spent, and the City has other needs for the funds so that this matter constitutes an emergency and this action is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON THAT RES 44-19 IS REPEALED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR THE REASONS SET FORTH HEREIN.


